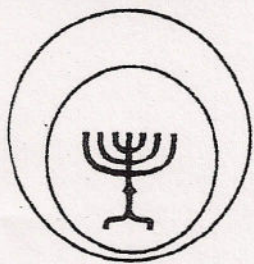

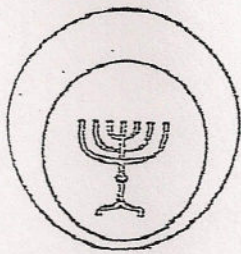

**Syosset, NY 11791**

**From Eastern Long Island:**

Northern State Parkway and/or LIE to Exit 44N(Seaford-Oyster Bay Expressway/Route 135. Go north on Route 135 to Jericho Turnpike (Route 25) West. Proceed west to Eileen Way-about 1 ½ miles. Turn left on Eileen Way to #120-Galil Importing Corp on the left.

**From Western Long Island:**

Northern State Parkway to Exit 35North(Rte 106/107) or LIE to Exit 41North. Proceed north to Jericho Turnpike(Route 25) East. Go east on Jericho Turnpike to Eileen Way-about 1 ½ miles. Turn right on Eileen Way to #120.
