






What is an atom, you say? Well, an atom is anything and everything!



I can be the rice in your bowl!






I can be the snow that falls on your tongue!





But did you know? Did you know that I can be you?




You see, everything in the world is made of atoms. That includes you, this book, and the Earth.

So if you're made of atoms and atoms can be anything doesn't that mean you can be anything?






You can be a painter!
